I have just got my switch control panel back from Wimborne Engraving, It, only took them a few days and have done a great job using the track layout I drew up for them. They have cut all the holes for the switches and bi colour LED's and made up the back panel for the sockets. They engraved the track on a multi-layer material to give a professional finish. They have made other panels for my previous layouts and was a quality supplier to my electronics business.

I have used an off the shelf desktop enclosure from RS Components and will order some different LED holders as the ones I bought are not secure enough. Most of the electronic components were purchased on line from Railwayscenics, who have a great selection of products. The switches will be used to switch Tortoise point motors (as recommended by Dave Round). Also following his advice, I have used separate 12-volt dc power supply to power the LED's and point motors I am pleased with results although it will take some time to wire it all up.
